PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:

OLD BUSINESS

1. Final papers will be signed for the purchase of the Catholic Church property on May 15.
2. Frank has talked to SPN and they are going to get a plan put together for the West Railroad project. This will be prepared this summer and then visited by all of the interested parties.
3. Mt. Vernon Economic Development group has begun digging the basement for their fourth house in the City. The City needs to come up with a 5 year plan that would include detailed improvements that are needed for the City.
4. Nuisance properties were addressed at the meeting. Letters will be sent out next week. The council wants to remind patrons that tires, unlicensed vehicles, junked vehicles are not to be stored on your property. If you have wood piles, they should be neatly stacked away from contact with buildings. The council asks that patrons spruce up their property now that spring is upon us.
5. Anderson has submitted the application for the West Nile prevention grant.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Motion by London, second by Renken to appoint Darin Maltberger to the Ward III seat vacated by Ken Martish. The Council would like to thank Ken Martish for his service on the Council. Maltberger will serve on the Council until the next city election.
2. Frank, London and Maltberger took the Oath of Office for elected officials and were seated as council members.
3. Election of Officers: W Frank, President, C. Deinert, Vice President.
4. The following are named chairman of each division: Streets and Alleys, Frank; Water, Anderson; Lights & Electricity, London; Park, Deinert; Garbage, Maltberger, Sewer, Renken.
5. Gene Deinert: potholes by Main and Railroad street need to be fixed, will get materials to take care of it. After road is bladed, will have dust control material applied. Lorang has expressed concern about drainage from the east side of the road of First Street to the east corner that needs to have some drainage issues taken care of. Lorang has offered his help with this drainage issue. Deinert will work on this issue. Tate Deinert has started working for the summer. They are getting the baseball fields and bathrooms ready for the season.
6. The city wants to remind patrons that date of the City wide cleanup is June 3. There will be dumpsters located at the city shop for residents to bring their garbage on Saturday morning. There will not be curb service for this unless you are unable to bring it to the shop. The cleanup will be from 8-12 on June 3. There will be a city-wide rummage sale on the evening of June 2 and June 3. This is a good opportunity for patrons to dispose of items that they no longer want. 7. The city website was discussed. Deinert brought some ideas to the council, she will continue to establish a more up to date and user friendly website.
